## 1 Introduction

The overall goal of the WBNET project was to introduce joint short study programs in the higher education institutions (HEIs) of the Western Balkans (WB) in the area of ICT. To achieve this goal one of the main steps undertaken was to build strong cooperation with economy partners through communication about knowledge gaps in labour market and involving them in curricula design. This was done through day-to-day communication, Interim conference and two round tables.

**First Round table** was done at UNBI from 2-3 September 2026, while **Second Round** table was realized from May 12th to May 13th 2026. Round tables involved partners from economy and project WBNET was presented to them, the big idea that should have its continuation after the project ends. This involved

Due that strong support of economy/business sector is crucial for short study cycles continuation after the project life, signing at least 40 agreements with companies where the practical professional part of the courses will be held is crucial.

Each WBHEI (AASKM, SVEHERC, UNIBI i UPKM) **had to sign at least 10 agreements (40 on consortium level)**. This was successfully completed by the end of May 2026, (42 signed agreements), while there are still activities ongoing regarding signing the new ones.

## REPORT

The fifth project meeting of the Network of Centers for Regional Short Study Programs in the Countries of the Western Balkans (WBNET) project was held in Bihać, at the Technical Faculty of Bihać, from September 2 to 3, 2025. This report covers ROUND TABLE, part of consortium meeting.

### First Day

The meeting began with the gathering and registration of participants from 9:30 to 10:00, followed by introductory presentations. At around 10:00, the program was officially opened by Husein Rošić, after which the participants were welcomed by Prof. Dr. Damir Hodžić, Dean of the Faculty of Technical Engineering, Prof. Dr. Nevzet Veladžić, Vice-Dean for Research and International Relations, and Adisa Eminoglu, representative of the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the Una-Sana Canton. Subsequently, dr. Amel Toroman introduced the host institution, the University of Bihać, as well as the Faculty of Technical Engineering. At 10:30, Prof. Dr. Ljiljana Pecić presented the WBNET project. She also outlined the project timeline, highlighting the activities implemented to date and the planned steps for the future, structured by work packages. From 11:00 onwards, company presentations took place. The first was held by Aida Štilić, who presented the work of RTV USK, explained the tools and

technologies they use, and described their main areas of activity, emphasizing that the media house currently employs 76 staff members.

This was followed by a presentation from *RTV Cazin*, delivered by Kenan Alagić, who spoke about the beginnings of the media outlet, which started as a radio station and later expanded to television broadcasting, initially limited to only a few hours per day. Today, RTV Cazin employs 19 staff members. The next presentation came from IDK Studio Bihać, presented by Dino Kišmić. He showcased examples of completed projects, ranging from smaller redesigns to the development of complete websites and applications from scratch. He also emphasized that the studio hosts internships not only for students of the University of Bihać but also for students from other universities across Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Following this, Samir Mešić, Director of *INFOSYS Bosanska Krupa*, gave a presentation on the development of the company, from its initial steps in client-server technologies to its current operations. He particularly highlighted the long-standing collaboration with Faculty of Technical Engineering, which has been ongoing for 15 years.

The final company presentation was delivered by Šahmir Bjelopoljač, Director of *R.E.D. COMPUTERS*. He introduced the company's activities across different segments, including sales, technical support for various institutions, specialized support in the medical sector, as well as student internship programs.

After the business presentations, from 12:00 to 12:15, a memorandum of cooperation was signed. This was followed by a *tour of the Faculty of Technical Engineering laboratories*, beginning with the computer center and continuing through the textile, wood industry, civil engineering and mechanical engineering laboratories, and concluding with the laboratory for automation.

Lunch followed until 14:30.

Aladin Crnkić presented on behalf of the University of Bihać (UNBI), highlighting important activities that had been implemented: amendments to the Law on Higher Education and the Statute of the University, the establishment of the Centre for Non-Cyclical Education, and the introduction of short study programs.

The final part of the day, from 16:30 to 17:00, was dedicated to a general discussion and conclusions on the topics addressed throughout the day.

## REPORT

The 6th Project Meeting within the Erasmus+ WBNET project was held on May 12–13, 2026, at the Department in Zvečan of the Academy of Applied Studies Kosovo and Metohija. The meeting gathered representatives of partner institutions from the Western Balkans and the European Union, including representatives of ATUSS Belgrade, University of Ljubljana, Universidad Politécnica de Madrid, University of Mitrovica and University of Bihać.

This report only covers activities dedicated to cooperation with economy partners during 6th Consortium meeting – ROUND TABLE.

### First Day

The meeting was officially opened by dr Milan Mišić, President of AASKM and dr Bojan Prlinčević, project coordinator, who emphasized the importance of international cooperation, modernization of higher education, and development of short study programs aligned with labour market needs.

During the first working day, after the short presentation of the host institution, project coordinator dr Ljiljana Pecic, presented the project WBNET and ongoing WBNET activities to project partners and representatives of the business sector. Special attention was devoted to strengthening cooperation between higher education institutions and companies through the

development of short study programs, micro-credentials, and practical training opportunities. As a conclusion, the lifelong learning is considered an important factor in the progress of society as a whole. Representatives of the business sector, Mr Srdjan Vucinic the director of Regional communal company in Mitrovica and Mr Nenad Radovanovic the director of Public communal company Zvečan, presented their experiences and discussed possibilities for future cooperation within project activities. Both of them pointed out at importance of short study programs, as possibility of gaining the necessary practical skills, as well as continuous interest of employees of their companies to participate in. Both institutions provided positive opinion of curriculums for short study programs.

Participants also visited the laboratories of the Department in Zvečan, where they were introduced to the equipment, teaching capacities, and practical learning environment used for the implementation of short study programs and professional training activities.

Discussions focused on achieved results, upcoming obligations, implementation of WP4 activities, and coordination of future tasks among partner institutions. Project coordinator dr Ljiljana Pecic presented the overall achievements and major tasks for the forthcoming period.

The Round Table 2 was additionally supported through media coverage provided by Televizija Most, which recorded a television report on the event. The report was broadcast during prime-time programming, contributing to the dissemination and visibility of project activities and results.

## Second Day

A special training session for staff members and mentors from companies was organized by WBNET coordinator dr Ljiljana Pecic, focusing on strengthening cooperation between academia and industry and improving mentoring capacities within short study programs.

The meeting concluded with a discussion of future project activities, partner responsibilities, and upcoming dissemination and implementation tasks. Special focus on the final project phases will be on short study curriculum fine tuning, enrollment of the second group of trainees as well as design and printout of project monography.

Participants expressed satisfaction with the progress achieved and emphasized the importance of continued cooperation in strengthening flexible and practice-oriented higher education models in the Western Balkans.

Total 23 participants took part in a two day meeting activities, 9 female and 14 male.
